



#### Notes from the Pastor

**BOOKS**: From time to time, I will recommend books on a variety of topics. Since we don't have Catholic Religious Goods stores anymore, Amazon becomes sometimes the easiest way to find books and even books on Kindle. All of these books are available in book form and on Kindle.

There has been a great deal of talk about the Eucharist lately so I will recommend two books:

*Why Go To Church? The Drama of the Eucharist* by Timothy Radcliffe, OP.

*Our One Great Act of Fidelity: Waiting for Christ in the Eucharist* by Ronald Rolheiser, OMI.

Prayer: Our Deepest Longing by Ronald Rolheiser, OMI

The Sower of Black Field, by Katherine Koch – this is a novel, based on a true story about a Passionist Priest from our Diocese (from Sharon, PA). It is the story of an American Priest in Nazi Germany. It is a story of a local hero.

I recommend these books not to rehash old teachings, but to help people grow deeper in their faith. Often times our Catholic Education ended with Confirmation Class during our Religious Education on Sunday mornings. These books challenge us to take that next step in our faith into a deeper relationship with God and with one another.

MASS CHANGES BEGINNING THIS WEEK: Starting September 1<sup>st</sup>, Mass at St. Teresa will be at 11:00am on Sunday.

**UPCOMING CHANGES**: Now that the official merger of St. Teresa of Avila Parish into St. Thomas the Apostle Parish has taken place there are some changes that you might need to be aware of.

• Most importantly, the 10:00 Mass at St. Teresa will move to 11:00am starting in September.

• We will be merging the two parish websites into one. At some point, if you go to St. Teresa's website, you will be automatically redirected to St. Thomas' website. This will allow us to keep everything in one place.

• We will also be combining into one parish envelope system. As a result, your envelope number may change.

• We will also be combining our online giving into one program. Currently we have one program for St. Thomas, We Share, and one for St. Teresa, Vanco.

• Many of these changes do not dramatically affect how things operate but help us at the office level to coordinate things better.

**LIFECARE MINISTRIES**: I received a very nice thank you note from Lifecare Ministries in regards to the Baby Bottle Drive that we held this summer. They were able to collect \$15,345.50 from all those who participated, and \$1,123.49 of that total came from St. Thomas Parish. 

#### Eucharistic Eucharistic Adoration THIS WEEK



I am the living bread that came down from heaven...

We will hold our monthly Eucharistic Adoration this week. It will be held on Thursday, Sept. 5th Adoration (8:00am) through Friday, Sept. 6<sup>th</sup> (8:00am) at Saint Thomas Church. It will also be held on

Friday, Sept. 6<sup>th</sup> (8:00am -12:00pm) at St. Teresa Church. All are welcome any time to spend a prayerful, quiet moment with our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament.

#### Holy Communion for the Sick and Homebound

We are very grateful for the help of trained and designated Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist in carrying our Lord to those who are sick and homebound. This service finds its origin in the very



beginning of the church. Extraordinary Ministers who take the Eucharist directly from Mass to the sick and homebound can either a) receive their pyx from the altar and be sent forth by the presider after Communion, or b) pick up the pyx after Mass from the Tabernacle and take the Blessed Sacrament immediately to the person who is to receive it. The long-standing directive first issued by Bishop Trautman, and repeatedly renewed by Bishop Persico, is that it is not permitted for those distributing the Eucharist to place the consecrated host in a pyx brought forward by the people in the Communion line at Mass and then return to their seat. Wherever this custom exists, it should cease.



Our offices will be closed on Monday, September  $2^{nd}$  so that our staff may enjoy time with family. We will re-open on Tuesday morning, September 3<sup>rd</sup>. If there is a sacramental emergency, please call the office number (814-663-3041) and follow the prompts to reach the priest and leave a message. Thank you.
