

# **Notes from the Pastor**

<u>BULLETINS</u>: I apologize for running out of bulletins last week. We have tried to cut back on the number of bulletins and when our order arrived there were bulletins from another church mixed in with ours. Some of the information from last week's bulletin is included here.

**FATIMA UPDATE**: This past week the property and buildings at Our Lady of Fatima were put up for sale through Sander Realty and Vicki Melnichak.

Thanks to all those who have been helping us clean out and move things from Our Lady of Fatima. Your help has been a tremendous blessing.

You may see some new things at St. Teresa and St. Thomas. We have tried to reincorporate various religious items from Our Lady of Fatima into each of the parishes.

**BOOKS**: From time to time, I will recommend books on a variety of topics. Since we don't have Catholic Religious Goods stores anymore, Amazon becomes sometimes the easiest way to find books and even books on Kindle. All of these books are available in book form and on Kindle.

There has been a great deal of talk about the Eucharist lately so I will recommend two books:

Why Go To Church? The Drama of the Eucharist by Timothy Radcliffe, OP.

Our One Great Act of Fidelity: Waiting for Christ in the Eucharist by Ronald Rolheiser, OMI.

Prayer: Our Deepest Longing by Ronald Rolheiser, OMI

The Sower of Black Field, by Katherine Koch – this is a novel, based on a true story about a Passionist Priest from our Diocese (from Sharon, PA). It is the story of an American Priest in Nazi Germany. It is a story of a local hero. (This book was just awarded a gold medal by Readers' Favorite in the category of Fiction- Religious Theme.)

I recommend these books not to rehash old teachings, but to help people grow deeper in their faith. Often times our Catholic Education ended with Confirmation Class during our Religious Education on Sunday mornings. These books challenge us to take that next step in our faith into a deeper relationship with God and with one another.




